Dear Ms. Jones:

In March of 2010 our office review Rockford's proposal to utilize CDBG funding for acquisition and demolition of 416 South Main Street, the Ziock Building. We provided a clearance for that action on March 23, 2010. Since that time we have been provided additional information on the historic significance of the property. As such, we now believe that the property meets eligibility requirements for the National Register of Historic places pursuant to criterion "A" for its association with the manufacturing history of Rockford.

Accordingly, the proposal to demolish the building would constitute an adverse effect as defined by 36 CFR part 800, the regulations of the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. You should notify the council of this finding and invite their participation into the consultation process. You should also provide us with any information you have on the condition of the building and any marketing efforts the City has completed thus far. We will then review this information and initiate the consultation process with you.
